The case of Michael Stone... and his "Dangerously Severe Personality Disorder"

- career criminal significant documented personality disorders
- Repeatedly disclosed violent detailed fantasies
- Released regardless...carried out his fantasies
- Public outcry...media uproar...
- Previous law around treatment of PD abolished
- Emergence of "Dangerous and Severe Personality Disorder Units"

What's the difference...why the confusion?



Psychopathy...

- Absence of "moral compass"-devoid of fear
- Lack of (inability?!) to feel empathy and remorse
- Superficially charming/glib/garrulous
- Meticulous in carrying out crimes/plots to avoid detection/risk to self
- Likely genetic-sig research shows underdeveloped parts of the brain



Sociopathy...

- No genetic causes-The clue is in the name!-societal/external forces to blame
- Moral compass skewed rather than absent
- Can interact with the social world in a meaningful way
- Have a sense of fear & "right and wrong"



Anti-social personality Disorder

- Ongoing pattern of disregard and violation of the rights of others
- Failure to conform to social norms with respect to lawful behaviour
- Deceitfulness/impulsivity
- Irresponsibility/aggressive/ manipulative behaviour
- Evidence of conduct disorder before aged 15



Psychopaths...but not criminals "Successful psychopaths"

- Traditional approaches don't fit
- ASPD is not always evident in psychopathy
 - more likely in sociopathy
- Hare-Snakes in Suits




PCL-R: The holy grail of Psychopathy?

- Has the measure become confused with the construct?
- Issues around using PCL-R outside of a forensic and male population
- Newer approaches moving away from a "lifetime score"
